ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- 1 The hangers are primarily a combination of soft netted scenery with hard framed tail-down pieces on the onstage ends.
- 2 The show in San Diego plays in two parts. Acts 1 & 2, followed by an intermission before Act 3.
- 3 The transition scene between Act 1 & Act 2 requires an exit for Nadir downstage of the Transition Scrim

4 Raised deck does NOT typically travel with the show.

- The raked deck is from SDO stock raker boxes, and may not be available to accompany the production.
- If you need it, we can discuss possible availability. It will add an additional \$\$\$\$\$ to the rental fee.

5 If show is cross loaded from container to trailer - the show fits in one trailer without the (raker) deck and two with the deck. The Scenery trailer should be an air ride with some logistics.




